## BYLAW NUMBER 45, 1969

## A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE PAYMENT OF REPAIRS, DAMAGE AND REPLACEMENT OF WATER METERS

The Council of the Village of St. Louis, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. Should a meter, while on the premises of the consumer, be damaged or destroyed, the cost of repairing or replacing the meter shall be paid for by the said consumer. The expense of installing the meter shall be paid by the owner or occupier of the property at the time of the installation.
- 2. Every owner or occupant of premises shall provide free and convenient access to his premises for the installation, inspection, removal, replacement and repair of meters in order that the Village may ascertain the same to be in good working order at all times.
- 3. Every owner or occupier of property shall provide adequate protection for the meter against frost, heat or any other internal or external damage.
- 4. Where water meters are damaged by hot water or frost, the owner or occupier as the case may be shall pay to the Village or Town on demand for repairs made by the Village or Town at the rates set forth in the parts list provided by Neptune Meters Ltd.; prices subject to change.
